








The Mongolian wild horse is less common than the domestic horse.

- 2 both the grizzly bear and the polar bear are endangered species in some areas. Their populations are decreasing.

- Big cats are among the world's most amazing creatures. The cheetah is one of the fastest animals. It can run as fast as cars can drive on the motorway. In contrast to what most people think, big cats are not all scared of water. Tigers and jaguars are strong swimmers.
- 2 Humans are a major threat to tigers. People hunt them for their skin and bones. They use their body parts to make medicine. Due to these practices, three subspecies of these big cats have become extinct in the past 80 years. Other subspecies are endangered.
- 3 Jaguars are losing their habitat. These cats live in the rainforest. As the rainforest is destroyed, they lose their hunting ground. These cats have survived for over two million years, but this may change.
