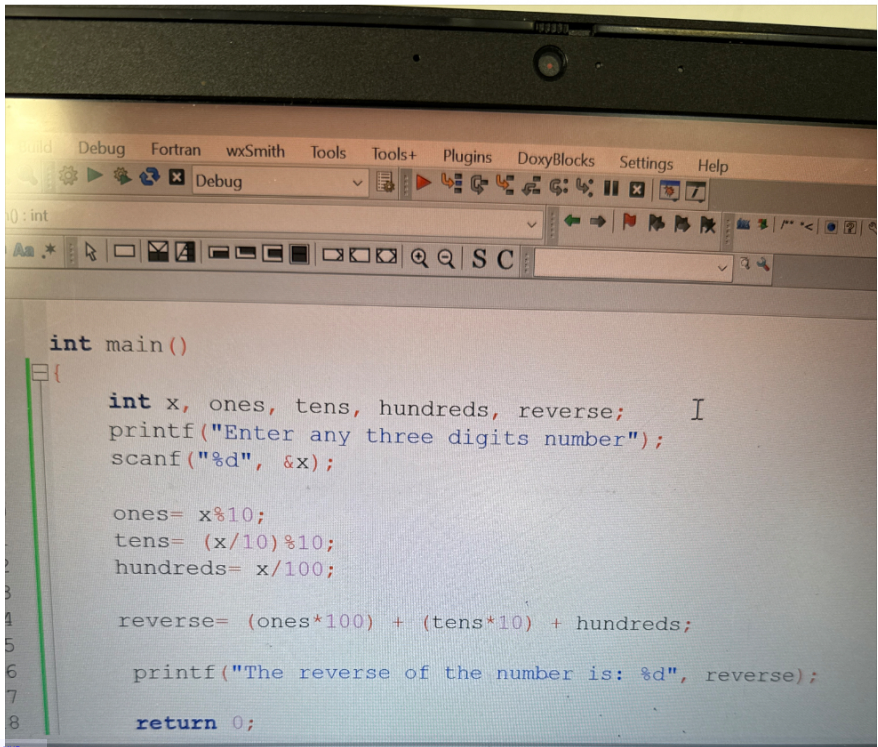


Question 6:
