INTRODUCTION

- What is Selenium?
 - Open-source automation testing tool.
 - Supports multiple browsers (Chrome, Firefox, etc.).
 - Features include scripting, debugging, and recording.

RECORD AND PLAY OVERVIEW

- What is the Record and Play feature?
 - Automatically generates test scripts as you interact with the browser.
 - It is useful for beginners to understand Selenium's basics.

SETTING UP SELENIUM IDE

- Install the Selenium IDE browser extension (Chrome/Firefox).
 - <https://chromewebstore.google.com/detail/selenium-ide/mooikfkahbdckldjjndioackbalphokd?hl=en>
- Open the IDE and create a new project.

RECORDING A TEST

- Click on the "Record" button in Selenium IDE.
- Perform actions (e.g., fill forms, navigate pages).
- Stop recording once finished.
- Save the test case.

PLAYING A TEST

- Select the recorded test case.
- Click the "Play" button to replay the steps.
- Verify results in the IDE logs.

ADVANTAGES AND LIMITATIONS

- Pros:
 - Easy for beginners.
 - Quick creation of tests.
- Cons:
 - Limited customization.
 - May require additional scripting for complex tests.
