1. Our planet is getting warmer and it is generally agreed that **this** is caused by the high levels of greenhouse gases, such as carbon dioxide (CO₂), in the atmosphere. These gases are created when we burn fossil fuels for energy. However, there are renewable sources of energy, which are better for the environment than fossil fuels. Two of the major alternative sources of energy are solar and hydroelectric.

More of our power needs to

2. Many countries, such as those in the Middle East, not only have plenty of oil but also plenty of sun. This sunshine, together with a lot of unused desert land, means that they are the ideal locations to build solar power plants. A power plant is any building where electricity is produced. And indeed, one of the largest solar power plants in the world is the Shams 1 plant in Abu Dhabi. The plant consists of over 258,000 mirrors, covering an area larger than 285



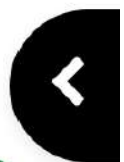
football pitches. The solar plant works by using the mirrors to focus heat onto pipes. These pipes are filled with a special type of oil. The heated oil is then used to produce steam, which drives the turbines, special machines that change mechanical energy into electrical energy. This process is just like what happens in a traditional electricity generating plant. The energy from this plant is enough to power over 20,000 homes. To produce this much power from fossil fuels, around 160,000 tonnes of CO₂ would be pumped into the air every year.

It is one of the few countries which generates most of its power from renewable sources. One of the most important hydroelectric power stations is on the Niagara River, near the world-famous Niagara Falls. Between 50% and 75% of the water from the river goes through four huge tunnels before the waterfalls. This water then passes through special turbines which provide energy to nearby areas of Canada and the United States. Once the water has passed through the turbines, it is then returned to the river.
